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OBJECTIVE

BACKGROUND

Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), an Autonomous body under Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, has entrusted with National Coordination Center (NCC) responsibilities related to Materiovigilance Programme of India (MvPI) since 2018 with an objective to improve Indian patient safety by monitoring, recording and analyzing the root cause of adverse events or risks associated with the use of medical devices and suggesting regulatory bodies for appropriate action with the sole intention of improving patient safety. MvPI program aims to promote and facilitate adverse event reporting of medical devices and subsequently evaluating these events.
